## “CHRIST IS MORE THAN ENOUGH”

HEBREWS 10:4-10

*For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.*

*Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said,*

*“Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired,*

*but a body have you prepared for me;*

*in burnt offerings and sin offerings*

*you have taken no pleasure.*

*Then I said, ‘Behold, I have come to do your will, O God,*

*as it is written of me in the scroll of the book.’”*



*When he said above, “You have neither desired nor taken pleasure in sacrifices and offerings and burnt offerings and sin offerings” (these are offered according to the law), then he added, “Behold, I have come to do your will.” He does away with the first in order to establish the second. And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.*

How can sinners be made right with a holy God? It is a question that stands at the very heart of the gospel. Hebrews 10:4–10 leads us directly into the answer, exposing the inability of sacrifices to take away sin and pointing us to the perfect and final offering of Jesus Christ.

In this passage, we are reminded that all human effort falls short. No ritual, no work, and no striving can accomplish what only Christ has done. In love and obedience to the Father, He came into the world, took on flesh, and offered Himself once for all as the sufficient sacrifice for His people.

As we gather, we are called to turn away from confidence in ourselves and rest fully in the finished work of Christ. He has done what we could never do. He has secured what we could never earn. Christ is more than enough.

# THE HIGHEST LEARNING

***“It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto Me.”***

***- John 6:45 KJV***

Someone once asked me if I had ever attended a religious seminary. I told them that I spent two years at one. They asked if I learned anything there. I told them that the main lesson I learned in the seminary I attended was this:

A person can read the Bible, study its history, learn its languages (Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek), and consort with other religious people, all without knowing the true and living God, all without knowing the true Christ of the Bible, and all without knowing the reality and glory of salvation by God’s grace in Christ. I learned that the most simple-minded people on earth who have been taught of God in the power of the Spirit through the Gospel, wherein the righteousness of God in Christ is revealed, are the smartest people on earth when it comes to the Bible and salvation. And I learned that the most intelligent people on earth who have not been taught of God are the dumbest in matters of truth as revealed in God’s Word.

The true church of the LORD Jesus Christ is a God-built institution, not just of higher learning, but of the highest learning. Salvation by God’s grace involves the LORD God in Christ by the Holy Spirit revealing, teaching, and convicting His children in the highest knowledge of all – the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Consider – “It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto Me.” (John 6:44)

In this godly school of the highest learning, we learn about God and Who He really is in His sovereignty, holiness, justice, grace, mercy, and love. We learn about ourselves and who we really are as the vilest of sinners, spiritually dead and depraved in ourselves, and in need of salvation by God’s grace and mercy. And we learn about Christ and Who He is in the glory of His Person, God manifest in the flesh, and in the power and success of His redeeming work to save us from our sins, work righteousness by which we are justified before God, and to give us spiritual life in the new birth and bring us all the way to glory. There is no greater teacher than the LORD God, and there is no higher learning than His Word of salvation in Christ.

## THE LIBERTY OF GRACE

*"That they all may be one: as Thou, Father, are in me, and I in Thee, that they also may be one in us" - John 17:21*

The liberty of grace in Christ is not freedom to sin. It is freedom for obedience, love, and service to God and to one another. Christ set us free when He died on Calvary; when He redeemed us by His precious blood and justified us by His righteousness imputed. When the Holy Spirit convicts us of sin and calls us to faith in Christ, He calls us into the liberty of God's grace in Christ. This works within us a love for Christ and His people and a desire to follow Him.

Any who use the liberty of grace as an excuse to promote sin show a lack of grace within the heart. Just as faith works by love (Galatians 5:6), liberty works by love. When God, the Holy Spirit, gives spiritual life, knowledge, and grace to a sinner, that sinner, for the first time in his life, is free to obey, to love, and to serve God acceptably in Christ. As the apostle Paul wrote, "But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life." (Romans 6:22)

# CHRIST IS MORE THAN ENOUGH

## HEBREWS 10:4-10



Have you ever tried really hard to fix something, but it just didn't work? Maybe you tried to clean up a mess but it still looked dirty. Or you tried to fix a broken toy, but it still didn't work the way it should.

The Bible tells us something important about sin. Sin is the wrong things we do, think, and say. And no matter how hard we try, we cannot fix our sin on our own.

In the Old Testament, God's people offered sacrifices like sheep and goats. These were important, and God told them to do it. But those sacrifices could not truly take away sin. They were like a picture pointing to something better that was coming.

That "something better" is Jesus. Hebrews 10 tells us that Jesus came into the world to do God's will. He didn't come just to teach people or do miracles. He came to give Himself. Jesus lived a perfect life and then died on the cross for sinners like us.

And here is the really good news. Jesus only had to do this one time. The Bible says He was offered "once for all." That means His sacrifice was perfect and complete. He doesn't need to do it again, and we don't need to add anything to it.

Sometimes we might think, "If I just try harder, maybe God will love me more." But God's love for His people is not based on how hard we try. It is based on what Jesus has already done.

Because of Jesus, our sins can be forgiven. Because of Jesus, we can be made right with God. Because of Jesus, we can have peace in our hearts.

So when you feel like you are not good enough, remember this truth: Jesus is more than enough.

Think About It: Why can't we fix our sin by ourselves? Remember This Verse:

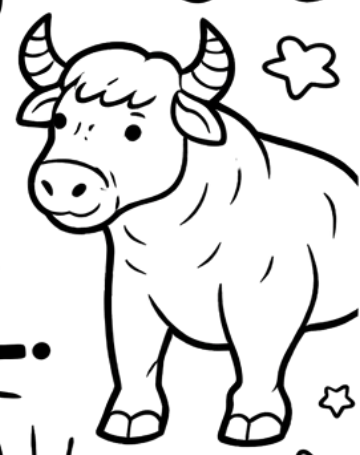
"And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all." – Hebrews 10:10

Prayer:

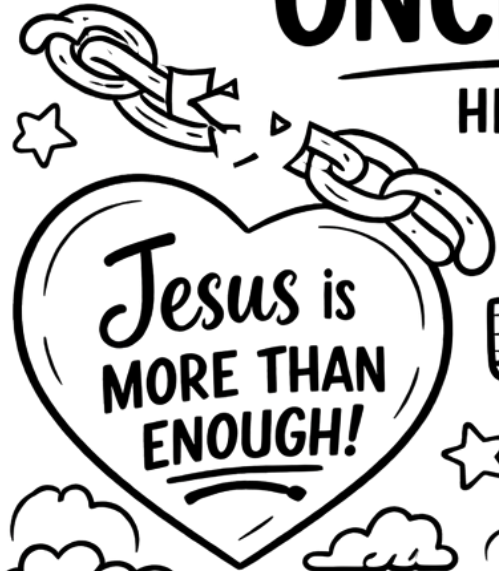
