## “THERE IS NONE HOLY LIKE THE LORD”

1 SAMUEL 2:1-10



There are seasons in life when God teaches His people to wait upon Him with patient faith. Hannah knew such a season well. For years she carried the burden of unanswered prayer, yet she continued to seek the Lord and trust in His goodness. When God graciously answered her cry, her response was not merely gratitude for a blessing received, but heartfelt worship directed toward the God who had proven Himself faithful.

In 1 Samuel 2:1-10, Hannah's prayer becomes a song of praise that celebrates the holiness, sovereignty, and faithfulness of the Lord. Her words lift our eyes beyond her personal story and point us to the character of God Himself. She declares that there is none holy like the Lord, none besides Him, and no rock like our God.

As we study this passage together, we are reminded that God reigns over every circumstance, sustains His people by His grace, and accomplishes His purposes throughout history. Hannah's testimony encourages us to place our confidence in the Lord alone, finding our joy, security, and hope in the One who is worthy of all praise.

# **GOD IS GOOD**

**Oh that men would praise the LORD for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness.”**  
**Psalm 107:8-9**

God is essentially good. All the time, in every way, God is good. The goodness which is ascribed unto God is peculiar only to Him; “There is none good but one, that is, God.” (Mark 10:18)

There is no being, created or uncreated, that is even close to being good compared to our God. As a matter of fact, we mere mortals have no idea of what this adjective means, when used to describe He who alone is good. Even those who have been quickened by His Spirit, have very little comprehension of the goodness of God. We see and experience His goodness more clearly as He satisfies our longing soul and fills us with His goodness. But we believe He is good all the time, because He says He is good.

To the unregenerate, God is believed to be good only when they are well and prospering in this world. When good things come their way, then they say, “*God is good.*”

When the child of God is afflicted, suffering, and stripped of all his earthly possessions, he bows his heart before the throne of mercy and worships God, and glories in his GOOD GOD. Our flesh may be ordained to suffer greatly while we are in this world, but our longing and hungry soul is ordained to be satisfied and filled with the goodness of God.

# NONE HOLY LIKE THE LORD

## 1 SAMUEL 2:1-10



"There is none holy like the Lord: for there is none besides you; there is no rock like our God." Have you ever waited a long time for something? Maybe you counted down the days until your birthday, a family vacation, or Christmas morning. Waiting can be hard!

In the Bible, Hannah waited a long time and prayed earnestly to God. She trusted Him even when things were difficult. When God answered her prayer and blessed her with a son named Samuel, Hannah did something wonderful. She praised the Lord.

Hannah's song reminds us that God is holy. That means He is perfect, good, and completely different from anyone else. There is no one like Him. Hannah also called God her "Rock." A rock is strong and dependable. Just as a large rock can provide a safe place to stand, God is a safe place for His people.

Sometimes life can feel uncertain. You may face a difficult test at school, a disagreement with a friend, or something that makes you worried. Hannah teaches us that we can trust God in every situation. He knows what we need, He hears our prayers, and He always does what is right.

Most importantly, Hannah rejoiced in God's salvation. God would one day send Jesus Christ, the Savior, to rescue sinners and bring them into His family. Through faith in Jesus, we can know God and enjoy His love forever.

When you pray this week, thank God for being your Rock. Praise Him for His goodness, His faithfulness, and His great love shown through Jesus Christ.

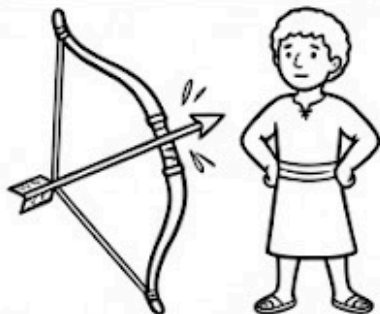

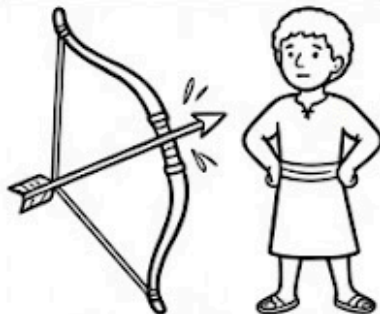
