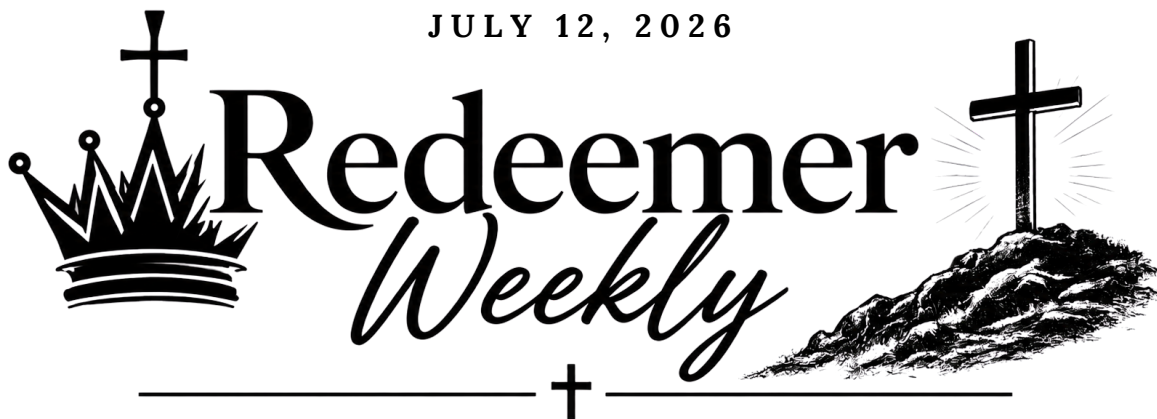

THE CERTAIN TRIUMPH OF GOD'S WORD

ISAIAH 55:10-13



There are moments in life when we wonder whether our labor has lasting value. We pray for family members who have yet to believe the gospel. We share God's truth with friends and neighbors and wait for evidence that hearts are being changed. We faithfully gather each Lord's Day to hear the Scriptures preached, trusting that God is at work even when His purposes unfold quietly.

Isaiah 55:10-13 reminds us that the Word of God never fails to accomplish His perfect will. Just as rain and snow descend from heaven to nourish the earth and produce a harvest, the Lord declares that His Word always fulfills the purpose for which He sends it. Every promise He has spoken is certain. Every work He has ordained will come to pass according to His sovereign wisdom and grace.

This passage calls us to renewed confidence in the power of God's Word. As we worship today, may our hearts be encouraged by the certainty of God's promises. Let us listen with faith, rejoice in His sovereign grace, and give thanks that the living Word of God continues to bring life, joy, and lasting fruit to all whom He calls.

May the Lord use His Word today to strengthen your faith and deepen your confidence in His unfailing promises.

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-CHILDREN'S DEVOTIONAL-

GOD'S WORD ALWAYS DOES WHAT IT SAYS

ISAIAH 55:10-13

So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose."

Isaiah 55:11

Have you ever planted a flower or a vegetable seed? Before anything can grow, the seed needs water. Rain falls from the sky, soaks into the ground, and helps the little seed begin to grow. Soon green leaves appear, and later there may be flowers, fruits, or vegetables.

God used this picture to teach us something wonderful about His Word.

In Isaiah 55, God says that His Word is like the rain. Rain falls from heaven and gives life to the earth. In the same way, God's Word comes from Him and brings life to His people. When we hear the Bible read, listen to a sermon, or memorize Scripture, God is at work through His Word.

The Bible is different from every other book. It is God's Word. He speaks to us through it. He teaches us about His holiness, our need for a Savior, and the good news that Jesus Christ came to save sinners. The Holy Spirit uses God's Word to help us trust Jesus and grow in our faith.

Sometimes we do not see God's work right away. A seed stays hidden under the soil before it begins to grow. In the same way, God is often working in hearts before anyone can see the results. We can trust Him because He always keeps His promises.

This week, thank God for giving us the Bible. Read a few verses each day with your family. Ask God to help you understand His Word and to grow in your love for Jesus. The Lord always does what He says, and His Word never fails.
